21. Observation/Suggestions to improve the overall teaching - learning experience in your institution.

- A large number of students felt that activity based learning should be implemented and assignments should be more application oriented.
- Some students felt that courses should be more research oriented.
- Some students felt that better graphics and visual media should be used to engage students.
- A large number of students felt that overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution is very good.
- A good number of student(s) pointed out that more than 90 percent syllabus was covered in the classes.
- Some common observations were as follows:
 - ❖ Teaching learning process should be made more interactive.
 - ❖ There should be improvement in basic infrastructure which facilitates Health & Hygiene. Labs should be better equipped.
 - ❖ The Internship & Training programme offered by the college is very helpful in overall development of student.
 - ❖ Many placement drives are conducted by the Training and Placement Cell which aid in getting employment.
 - ❖ Various opportunities are given to participate and perform in extra-curricular activities.

- ❖ The central library should be equipped latest editions of books as well as e-books. Researchers should be facilitated with plagiarism software
- ❖ Overhead Projectors, Digital Boards, Microphone & Speakers should be made available in all the classrooms.
- ❖ More time should be given to students to prepare for exams.

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
