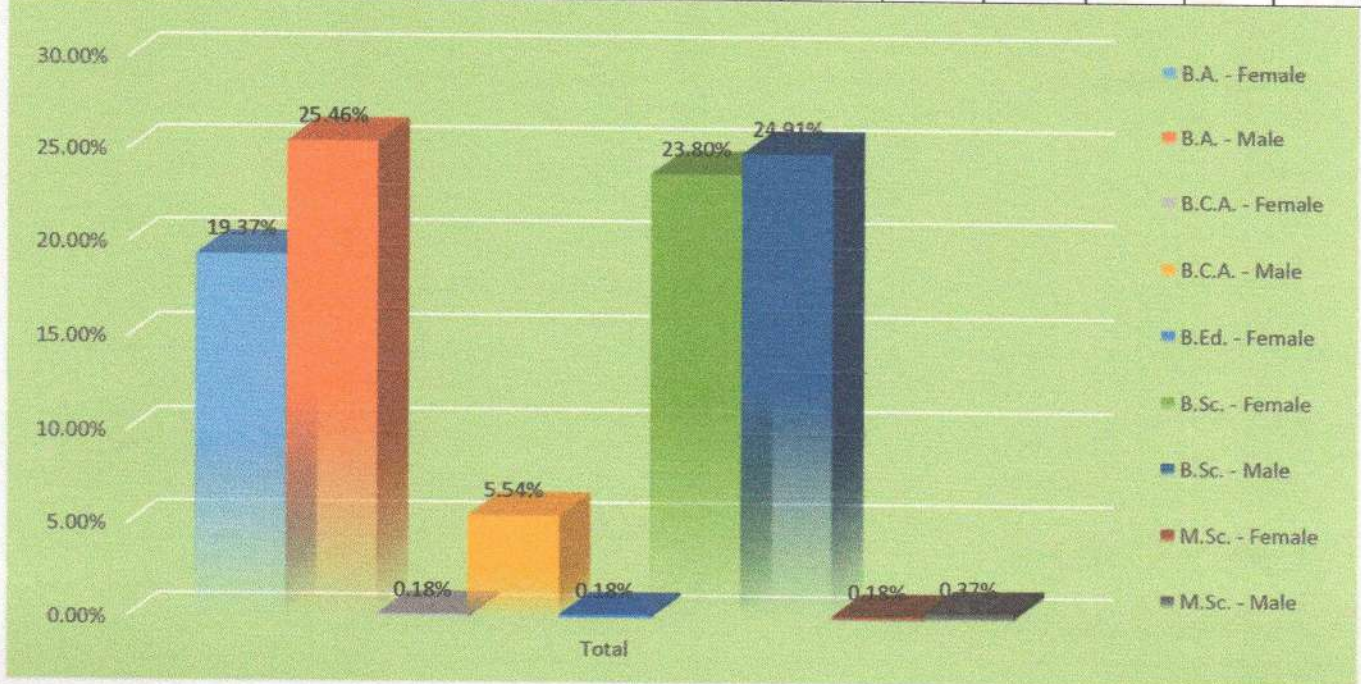
UNDER CRITERION II OF TEACHING - LEARNING AND EVALUATION

21.Observations/Suggestions to improve the overall teaching - learning experience in your institution.

- A large number of students () felt that the teaching-learning process in the institution is very effective and regular classes are held.
- A good number of students () pointed out that more than 90 percent syllabus was covered in the classes.

- Majority of learners () agreed that the institution provides value added courses imparting life skills to them.
- A large number of students () expressed that the teachers used ICT tools and e-resources such as LCD projectors, Multimedia etc. in teaching.
- A good number of students () acknowledged that different units of the college provide multiple opportunities to learn and grow by organising extra-curricular activities.
- More than percent students expressed that the college has well-furnished support facilities like-laboratories, libraries, computers, ICT enabled classrooms etc.
- Approx. 60 percent students felt that the college makes due effort for campus placement.
- Approx. 70 percent students stated that there should be improvement in the infrastructure
- Approx. 60 percent students opined that research facilities require improvement in the college.
- Percent students felt that there should be more opportunities for community service and more excursions should be organised.
- Some students felt that the syllabus of some programmes should be revised
- Majority of the students opined that the Central Library should be completely digitalized. A large number of students felt that overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institution is very good.
- Teachers should identify slow learner and advance learner in their class.
- LCD Projectors, Digital Boards, Microphone & Speakers should be made available in all the classrooms.
